The sending higher education institution supports the staff mobility as part of its modernisation and internationalisation strategy and will recognise it as a component in any evaluation or assessment of the staff member.

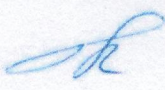
The staff member will share their experience, in particular its impact on their professional development and on the sending higher education institution, as a source of inspiration to others.

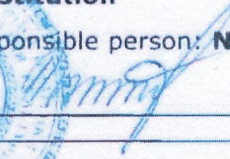

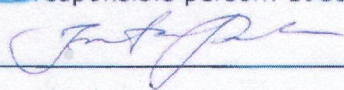
